Course Overview

The Qualsafe Level 3 Award in Risk Assessment (RQF) is a regulated and nationally recognised qualification specifically designed for those who have a responsibility for conducting risk assessments in low risk environments, such as supervisors and site managers. The qualification is also suitable for those who significantly contribute towards the risk assessment process, such as team leaders and technicians

Over a 2 day period, candidates will learn about the principles and practical skills involved in risk assessment, the relationship between hazards and risks and how to apply the hierarchy of controls when completing risk assessments.

What's Covered?

- Main causes and costs of work-related accidents and ill health
- Health and safety responsibilities of employers and employees
- Provisions for risk assessment contained in key legislation
- Enforcement of health and safety laws
- Principles involved in risk assessment:
 - Competencies required of a risk assessor
 - Sources of information and advice for carrying out workplace risk assessments
 - Stages of risk assessment
 - Requirements for recording, monitoring, reviewing and revising workplace risk assessments
- Relationship between hazard and risk as part of an accident and ill health prevention strategy
- Control measures for different workplace hazards
- Determining suitability of control measures
- Completing a risk assessment including:
 - Collecting relevant information
 - Analysing the level of risk and who may be exposed
 - · Making suitable recommendations
 - · Recording and communicating findings effectively

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
